

NOTICE OF MEETING OF STONEYBROOK COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT

Notice is hereby given that the Board of Supervisors ("**Board**") of the Stoneybrook Community Development District ("**District**") will meet on April 13, 2020 at 9:00 A.M., and for this meeting and all subsequent regularly scheduled community development district ("**CDD**") meetings, conduct public meetings by the following means of communications media technology pursuant to Executive Orders 20-52 and 20-69 issued by Governor DeSantis on March 9, 2020, and March 20, 2020, respectively, and pursuant to Section 120.54(5)(b)2., Florida Statutes. This change in the conducting of meetings will continue until these Executive Orders expire.

The April 13, 2020 meeting is being held for the necessary public purpose of considering budgeting and related impacts of the COVID-19 Virus on the CDD owned and managed infrastructure and recreational facilities, at such time, the Board is so authorized and may consider any business that may properly come before it. The Board will adopt an emergency resolution describing the conduct of the meetings via communications media technology

While it is necessary to hold the above referenced meeting of the District's Board of Supervisors utilizing communications media technology due to the current COVID-19 public health emergency, the District fully encourages public participation in a safe and efficient manner. The meeting is open to the public and will be conducted in accordance with the provisions of Florida law for community development districts.
